## Next Meeting, April 8, At Rainsville Shop

Our next meeting will be on Saturday, April 8, at the Rainsville Blacksmith Shop on the Illiana Showgrounds. We will get our exciting first look at the new metal walls and major electrical improvements to our extensively renovated blacksmith shop.

A small crew is needed to help install a prototype ventilation system for the first two coal forges. This ventilation system will take smoke from two sidedraft hoods, combine the flow in a Y-shaped vertical duct, and exit the smoke straight out through a new hole in the roof. Sheet metal work for this is ongoing.

In addition, some gravel fill needs to be placed around the concrete slabs under the new steel doors. This will require some shovel work by a fill crew. Other site preparation tasks will also need to be completed.

A short business meeting will start at 9:00 AM.
